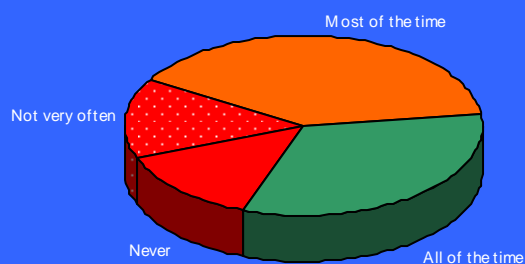
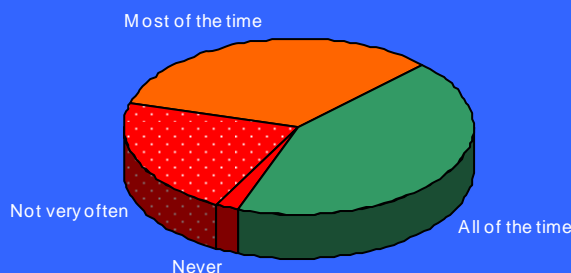


Participation in decisions - survey results

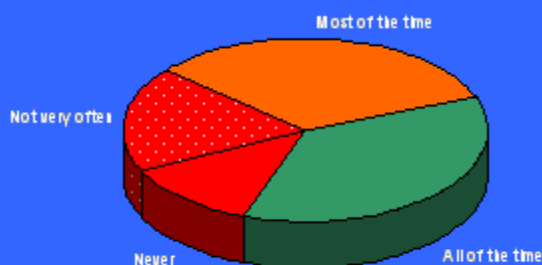
Does your social worker ask for your views on important things, like school, home, seeing your family, sport?

Do people explain decisions made about you?

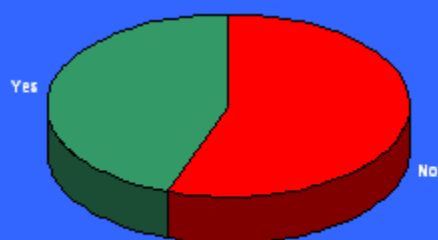


Do people listen to what you want?

- 92 children and young people aged from 4 to 18
- 48 were female and 44 were male
- 19 were of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent
- They lived:
 - with carers
 - with family
 - in residential care
 - independently
