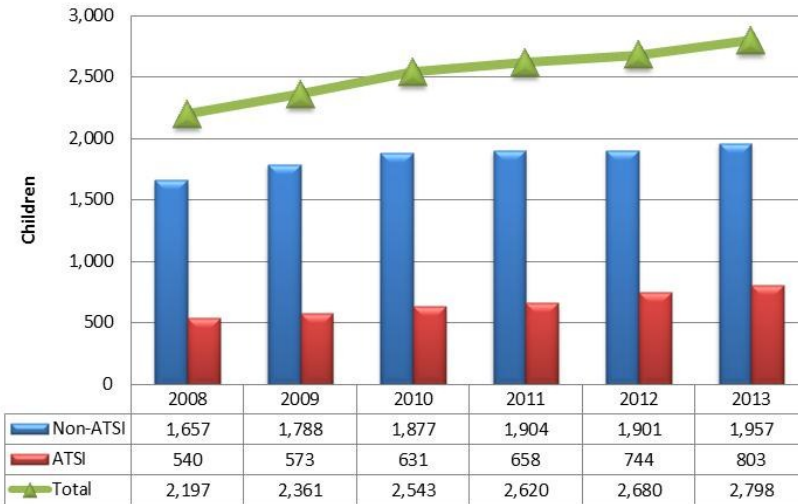


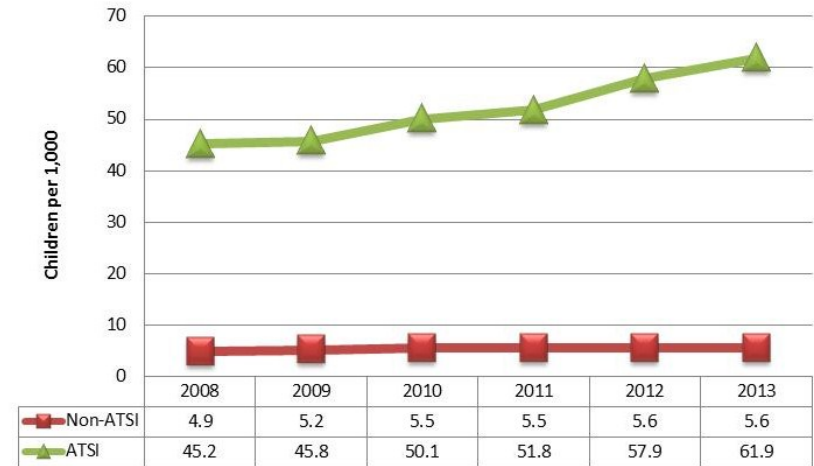

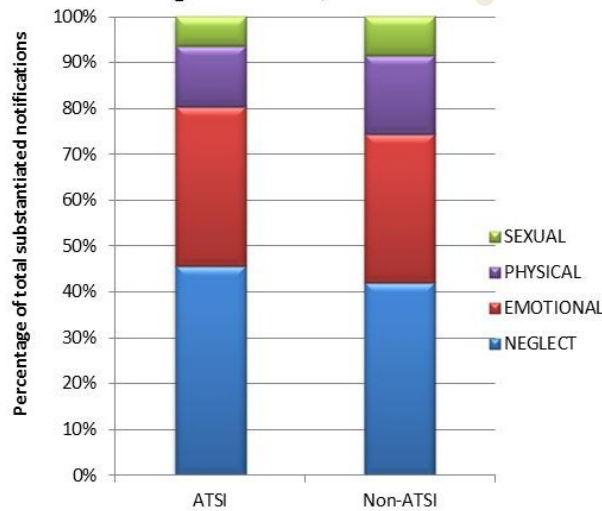
Children on Care and Protection Orders in SA



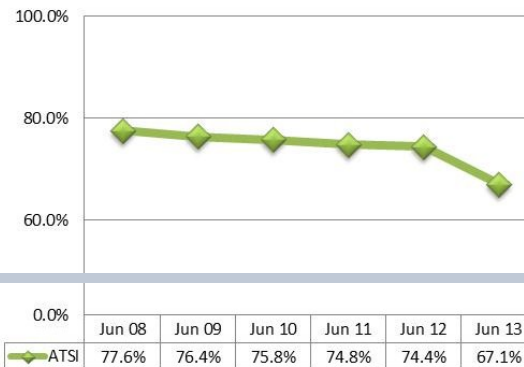
Children on Care and Protection orders in SA, per 1,000 of population



Substantiated notifications of child abuse/neglect in SA by type and Aboriginal status, 2012-2013

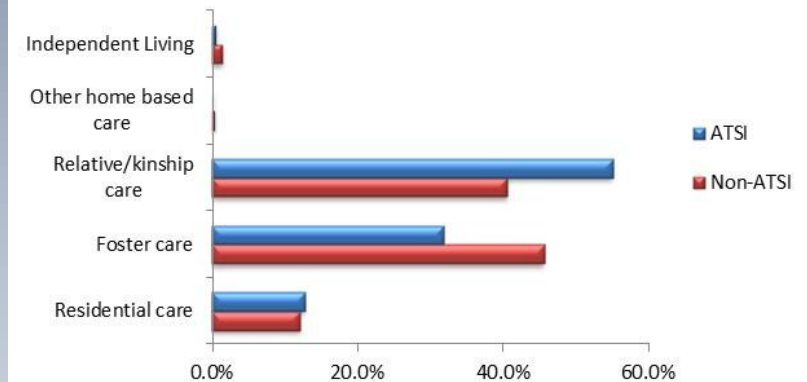


Aboriginal children placed in accordance with Aboriginal CPP, as % of all ATSI children in OOHC



Placement in accordance with the Aboriginal Child Placement Principle is defined as the number of Indigenous children placed with the child's extended family, Indigenous community or other Indigenous people, divided by the total number of Indigenous children in out-of-home care.
