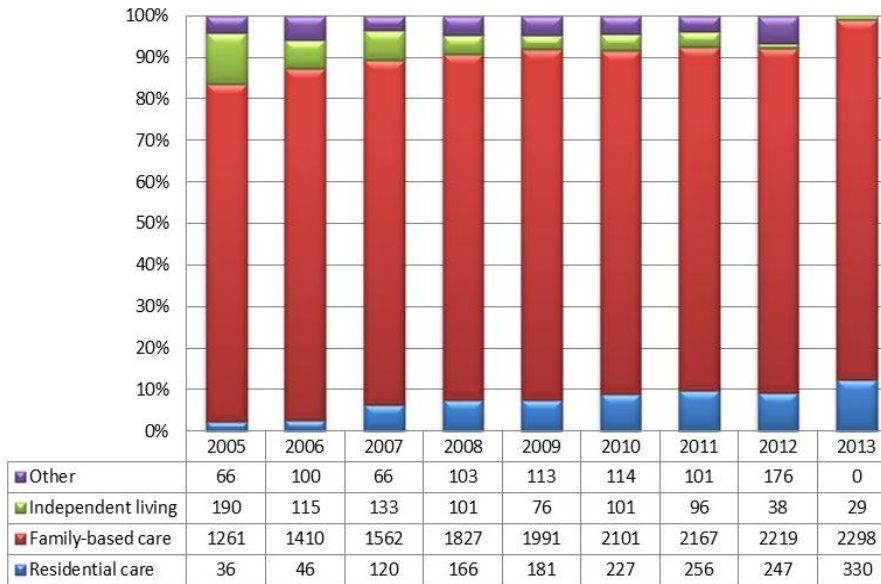


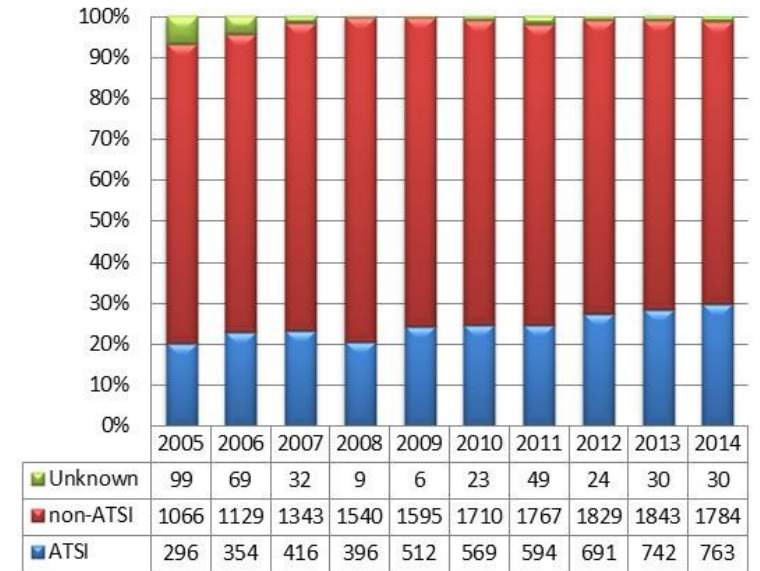
# Young people in state care and custody in South Australia

At June 30 2014 there were 2,577 children and young people under the guardianship of the SA Minister for Education and Child Development.<sup>1</sup>

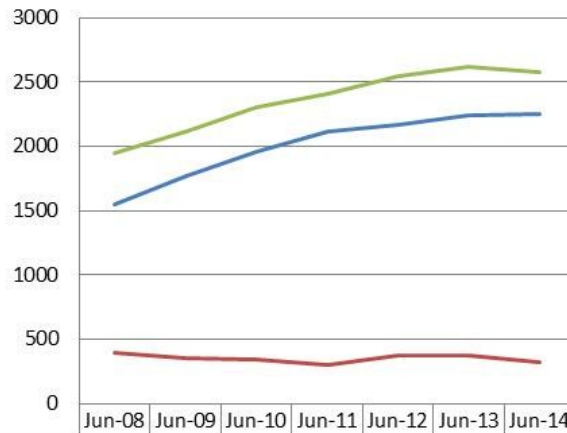
## Living arrangements (AIHW specification)<sup>2</sup>

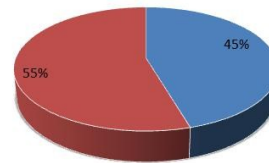

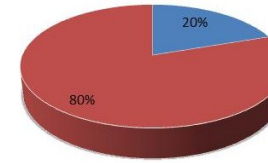
### Aboriginality

■ ATSI ■ non-ATSI



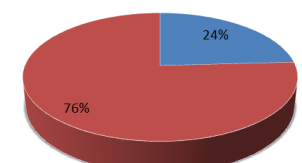
### Guardianship status

■ Guardianship ■ No order

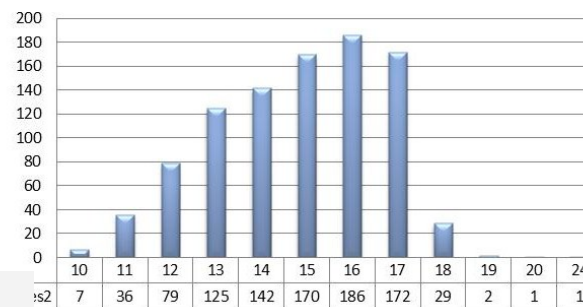


### Gender
